

## The Physical Environment PortaModule 2 Examples of Improved Compliance for LS.02.01.20 EP 1 and 1 ð

Issue: Maintain the Means of Egress clear of obstructions, and appropriate door locking. Objects stored in the Means of Egress, such as a corridor, restrict staff and patient movement in both normal and emergency situations. Door locking must not place occupants at risk.

Risk: Possible staff injuries and reduced evacuation of patients during an emergency

situation.

Impact: Patients at risk during an emergency and possible increase in Staff injuries. Doors locked may inhibit rescue of patients and staff. Staff injuries reduce the work force, and may increase workers compensation. Patients that are unable to be quickly transported because of corridor clutter may reduce patient care delivery or rescue. Doors improperly locked may also reduce rescue efforts in an emergency situation.
